

Creative Discipleship focuses on four key spiritual habits.

QUIET TIME

Word of Life's daily devotional to encourage consistency in spending time in God's Word. Small group leaders set goals for each student encouraging them to be in the Word daily throughout the year.

SERVICE

Service in the community and the local church is a natural outcome of walking with God. We provide creative and detailed ideas to get students serving.

SCRIPTURE MEMORY

Twenty four verses come paired with a key question to help students remember and apply scripture in their lives.

Bible Study - Students take notes during the lesson each week with a fill-in-the-blank style page for each lesson enabling them to engage and understand the truth they are learning.

SCHOLARSHIPS GUIDELINES

Here are the guidelines a student must meet in order to earn the scholarship during a particular year:

- Complete a minimum of 180 days of Quiet Time in one ministry year. (This works out to an average of 5-6 days per week during the school year.)
- Memorize 24 verses and score at least 80% on a written, fill-in-the-blank exam at the end of the year.
- Complete at least 18 service activities.
- Participate in at least 20 weeks of the weekly Bible Study using the Word of Life curriculum.

CREATIVE DISCIPLESHIP SCHOLARSHIP

This award can be earned annually from 7th through 12th grade. Each year earned, they receive 25% off at Word of Life Island and a \$500 scholarship to the Word of Life Bible Institute. Many other Christian colleges and universities also honor this scholarship.
